


**1. ISAAC BURLESON**, born May 20, 1842 in STANLY CO NC; died April 8, 1910 in BURLESON CEM #1 ALBEMARLE NC. He was the son of **2. WILLIAM (BILLIE) BURLESON** and **3. SARAH HARWOOD**. He married **(1) MARY ANN HEARNE**. She was born February 1841, and died November 11, 1897 in BURLESON CEM #1 ALBEMARLE, NC. She was the daughter of JOSHUA HEARNE and ELIZABETH (BECKY) STONE.

# Isaac Burleyson

Company C 42nd North Carolina Hoke's Brigade 1842 - 1910

Isaac was the third son of William "Billie" and Sarah Harwood Burleyson of Little Bear Creek in Stanly County. He enlisted into the Confederate Army on February 1, 1862. His service started as a prison guard at Salisbury and ended at Bennett's Place in May 1865. This included service with the Army of Northern Virginia.

The 42nd saw action in the Eastern part of North Carolina in 1862 and 1863. In 1864 the 42nd, Hoke's Brigade, was sent to defend Richmond. General Grant suffered greatly in his attack at Cold Harbor against Hoke's Brigade.

The 42nd was positioned in the center and all other regiments were aligned to the left and right of the 42nd at Bentonville. This was the very last battle to stop Sherman's much larger army.

Isaac gave his service in full measure from February 1862 until the final Confederate surrender and the disbanding of the 42nd on May 2, 1865 at Center Church in Randolph County.

Isaac returned to Stanly County after the war to marry Mary Hearne and there they raised their family and helped to rebuild their community. Today they lay in rest in the family graveyard on Burleson Road.

Notes for WILLIAM (BILLIE) BURLESON:

GrandPa Billie as he was known on Canton Road was quite a character. Almost all the older Burlesons remember him and they all have stories passed down about him. He raised two families. His first wife was Sarah Harwood. They raised seven known children, two girls and five boys. Sarah died sometime prior to 1860.

William (Billie) Burleson was conscripted on April 10, 1864 into the 34th NC, part of Scale's Brigade. Billie had three sons already in the service: Absolem in the 10th Artillery, Ebin in the 28th NC, and Isaac in the 42nd NC. Howell would follow in June 1864, He was a 51 year old widower with seven children when he was taken prisoner on 6 May 1864 in the opening battles of the Wilderness Campaign. Billie returned home at the end of the war to be united with his four oldest sons, all hardened veterans of the war. He married Rhoda Springer and raised seven more children. By: JD Burleson

## Men of the William "Billie" Burleson Family That Served North Carolina

William "Billie" Burleson was born in 1812 on the Little Bear Creek in the Western part of Montgomery County that is now known as Stanly County. Billie's grandfather, Isaac, was given this land for his service in the fight for American Independence. Isaac received 100 acres for serving as an infantryman for North Carolina.

The leaders of Stanly County anticipated the War Between the States. They raised a company of infantry for State Service two weeks before North Carolina seceded. Billie's two younger brothers, Lee and Nathan, would join the first day and both would die in the war.

Before the war concluded at Appomattox, every Burleson listed as "Head of Household" in the 1860 census from Stanly County and their sons of age served our Confederate States of America.

In February 1862, Billie's third oldest son Isaac, age 20, volunteered in Company C 42nd Infantry. He would serve North Carolina and the Army of Northern Virginia.


In March of 1862 Billie's second oldest son Ebin, age 22 volunteered for Company K of the 28th Infantry.

In August 1862 the oldest son Absalom, volunteered for the Artillery.

Billie himself was conscripted in April 1864 to Scales Brigade.

The fourth oldest son, Howell, age 16, was conscripted in June 1864 into the 70th Regiment of Junior Reserves.

Billie's two daughters were both married to husbands who served our South. William Hatley enlisted at age 22 years in March 1862 into Company C 42nd Infantry. Daniel Bowers was conscripted into Company F 5th North Carolina. This left only the youngest son William Jr., age 13, at home to protect and provide for the seven families whose heads of household were gone to war. By: John Hoyle Burleson



Sarah Ann Sides was the only child of Charlie and Betsy Almond Sides. After Sarah's birth, I can find no record of Betsy. In fact, I can find no record of her before this. She fits into no other Almond line I can find. My only knowledge of Betsy comes from my Grandfather, John F. Burleson, when he records Charlie Sides and Betsy Almond as parents of Sarah Ann, his mother on her death certificate.

Did Betsy die in child birth? This is very possible. We do know that Charlie married Sophis Lyerly on November 17, 1844, the daughter of Jacob and Mary Moose Lyerly. From this union came 10 more children.

As you can see the Sides family was always in Sarah's mind and heart. The Sides family was also in the mind and heart of the Burleson family. From the 11 Sides children two Burleson brothers, Absalom and Eben, would marry sisters Sarah and Mary. Nephew Hurley would marry Lillie.

Sarah would also name her children after her brother and sisters, Frances, Attie and William Columbus(this was passed on to a son Guy and Mildred Burleson).

Our Harwood connection must be documented also. Absalom Harwood who after his service in the American Revolution settled on Bear Creek and became the first Harwood to establish in Stanly County a link to the Burlesons. His son Howell married Celia and they had 13 children. The oldest Sarah, married William Billie Burleson, and son, Absalom, would marry Billie's sister Dovey.

These two couples (Burleson and Harwood) honored their spouse's families by naming their children after them. We find Absalom, Eben, Howell Burleson and Isaac, William, Davidson Harwood.

The third connection, Davidson, who was the youngest child of Howell and Celia Harwood. We find Davidson a Deputy Sheriff of Stanly County in 1860 with his wife Sara Anne and child Frances. In 1861 a son, David B., was born. We do not know what happened to Davidson, but we know that Absalom Burleson and Sara Anne Sides Harwood took up housekeeping and had 10 children.

#### Notes for EBIN BURLESON:

This is a article that was published in the Parapet, a newletter put out by the Point Lookout POW Org. Nov/Dec 1999.

Ebin Burleson lived in Stanly County, NC. He had fair complexion, red hair, blue eyes and was five and a half feet tall. At age 24, he fought in all of Lee's campaigns beginning on March 15, 1862. Ebin even witnessed his company's regimental flag being taken at the wall by the 126th NY Inf. It was during that battle that cousin J. Benjamin Burleson, 37th NC Infantry, left on the field, wounded for the third time (once in the hand at Fredericksburg), was captured and sent to Point Lookout POW camp. Uncle Joseph Burleson was captured at Harrisonburg, VA (after being shot in the right thigh 6 days prior at Winchester); cousin David Derric Burleson, 5th NC Inf, was captured at Cedar Creek; cousin John Wesley Burleson, 28th NC Inf, was captured at Waterloo, cousin William Burleson, 42nd NC Inf, was captured at Cold Harbor...all sent to Point Lookout! William died after a transfer to Elmira Prison. On April 2, 1865 Ebin was captured at Petersburg. He too, was sent to Point Lookout POW Camp until his release on June 23, 1865.

Ebin and his relatives were true Southerners. His father, known as Grandpa Billie was conscripted because of the chartest of man in 1864 at the age of 521 I



because of the shortage of men in 1864 at the age of 52! He also had four brothers, Absolem, Isaac, and Howell to serve the CSA. Several of the teenage Burleson cousins were registered with Junior Reserves!

In 1893, Ebin married nineteen year old Dora Hopkins and they had eight children. The last baby girl was born on April 4, 1914 and they named her Dallie Mae. Dallie Mae Burleson Moore is our latest PLPOW Real Daughter!

Ebin farmed all his life and lived to be 89 years old. He is buried in a private family cemetery in Stanly Co NC.

Last month, the Burlesons hosted a family reunion, with over one hundred in attendance. A program was presented, highlighting their family members who had served in The War Between The States. At this time, John D. Burleson, Ebin's great grandson, adorned with his PLPOW medal with four stars, presented 85 year old Dallie Mae with her PLPOW Real Daughter certificate! Dallie Mae will receive a free lifetime membership in our Descendants Organization.

The Burleson Family have discoved that their ancestors have been true patriots for over 200 years, starting with American Revolution in the NC milita during our first war for Independence, all the way down to present day. Last year, they honored all 65 of their Burlesons who had been WWII veterans.

There's nothing like family pride and preserving your family's heritage for the present generation and for those who'll follow in your footsteps when you're gone. We need to do as this family has done....tell and show our children!

#### Ebin Burleson

#### Private Company K, 28th North Carolina Troops

Branch/Lane Brigade

Ebin Burleson was born January 11, 1839, the son of William (Grand-paw Billie) and Sarah Harwood Burleson. He was a farmer and a life long resident of Stanly County and made his home on Burleson Road. According to his military records, he had fair complexion, red hair, blue eyes and was five and a half feet tall. At age 24, he enlisted for the war on March 15, 1862 and fought in all of Lee's campaigns. Ebin was a member of Company K. 28th NC Regiment which was part of the Branch/Lane Brigade. He witnessed his companies' regimental flag being taken at he wall by the 126th NY Inf. It was during that battle that cousin J. Benjamin Burleson, 37th NC Infantry, left on the field, wounded for the third time (once in the hand at Fredericksburg), was captured and sent to Point Lookout POW camp.

On April 2, 1865 Ebin was captured at Petersburg. He too, was sent to Point Lookout POW Camp until his release on June 23, 1865. Family tradition says Ebin was starved half to death and was almost blind when he arrived home. It took several years for him to recover.

Ebin was active in Stanly County's reunions of Confederate Veterans. He died at the age of 89 on January 27, 1927, and was buried at Burleson Cemetery #2 on Parker Road in Stanly County, NC, where he rests today with his wife Dora Hopkins Burleson. By: John D. (JD) Burleson

# Joseph Burleyson

#### Private Company K 57th North Carolina Jubal Early's Division

Joseph Burleyson was the son of Isaac Jr. and Katherine Castle Burleyson. He was a life-long resident of Stanly County and made his home in the Little Bear Creek area. Joseph and his wife, Lucy Almond, raised three sons that fought for the Confederate Army. The oldest son, William, was a member of Company C 42nd Regiment and died as a prisoner at Elmira, New York. The middle son, John, died from disease while a member of Company H 14th Regiment, according to the pension records of Stanly County. Dennis was conscripted at age 16 into the 70th Regiment, but survived the war.

Joseph, age 41, was conscripted in March1864 into Company K 57th Regiment, General Jubal Early's Division, but on August 31 at Winchester, he was shot through the hip and captured. After hospitalization in Baltimore and Yankee prison at Point Lookout, Joseph returned to Stanly County after he was released. He raised a large family.

My records show that Joseph was never paid his eleven dollars a month pay as a private because of his wounding and capture, but he surely paid a high price for the Southern Cause. He lost his brothers, Lee and Nathan, and his two oldest sons. William and John.

Years later, he was active in Stanly County's reunions of Confederate Veterans. He died at age 80 on February 24, 1902, and was buried at Friendship Methodist Church in Plyler, where this soldier rests today.

Who is Isaac Burleson, Sr. ?

Isaac Burleson was the founder of the line which resulted in most of the Burlesons of Stanly County. We know the following about him. He served his country in the American Revolution as a member of Captain Charles Polk's Company of the North Carolina Militia. Records proving his service are contained in Record Group 93 (# 461) in the National Archives. Most of his service was in the Cross Creek (Fayetteville) area of the state, helping put down uprising Tory, or Loyalist, forces who continued to support King George. In 1785, following the Revolutionary War, the United States awarded ISAAC BURLESON, 100 acres of land along the Yadkin River in Montgomery County, probably as a reward for his services at Cross Creek

It is believed that Isaac was born either in Lunenburg Co., Virginia or Cumberland Co., North Carolina around 1750. ISAAC'S name first appears on a tax list in Montgomery Co. (now Stanly) in 1782. In the 1790 Census, he is shown as a resident of Montgomery County, with a wife, Martha Clay and three children; Isaac Jr. age 10, Jonathan age 8, and Rachel (infant). Tradition says ISAAC'S wife, the former Martha Clay, was related to Henry Clay, the outspoken Kentucky senator. Isaac and Martha went on to produce five more children; Jane, David, Joseph, an unknown child, and Thomas. Each of these children is another story in itself.

On Nov 5, 1794, Isaac Burleson recorded his purchase of 100 acres of land on Little Bear Creek about 300 yards below the mouth of Running Branch. This is according to Montgomery County land entries, file number 1033, grant book 94, page 80.

The 1800 Census shows ISAAC BURLESON to be a man more than 45 years of age, with his wife between 26 and 45, three male and five female children. A land grant to ISAAC BURLESON in November, 1815, file number 1870, grant book 125, page 386, mentions the property of ISAAC BURLESON dec'd as a line mark, so by this time ISAAC had died and his son was receiving the grant.

# Honoring the Grave of a Revolutionary War Soldier

May 28, 1995 by P.K. Burleson

In 1988 I was invited to become a member of the Battleground Chapter of the Sons of the American Revolution here in Burlington, However, there was the N.C. requirement that I must prove that I actually was a descendant from Revolutionary War ancestor: thus began my Burleson family research.



My first endeavor was a trip to Raleigh, NC, --NC Department of Archives-- where I began an exhaustive search through Census Records, Birth Certificates, Marriage Bonds/Certificates, Wills, Deeds, and Land Sale Records.

Eventually, I was able to verify four Burleson generations beginning with Jape C. Burleson (b. Oct 26, 1884), Adam Burleson (b. Jan 29, 1847), Lee Burleson (b. 1826), and Isaac Burleson Jr. (b. 1784). During this lengthy process, I did secure the assistance of a Professional Genealogist who was able to provide additional Burleson information working toward completion at this point.

Information on the next generation back was that of Isaac Burleson, Sr. which seemed to be more difficult to establish. Fortunately in the fall of 1991, I was referred to Thurman Burleson who, supposedly, had much information on Burleson families, and who was a active member of the Burleson Family Association, Dallas, Texas; and, further, had attended several of the Annual Meetings.

Thurman and I had several telephone conversations and he confirmed the Burleson information which I had been able to assemble. When I mentioned the fact that I had been unable to find a record of Isaac Burleson being in the military, he immediately gave me information that Isaac Burleson's enlistment was in South Carolina (my search had been in NC only). Records confirmed his enlistment was with the 5th SC Regiment-Revolutionary War-April 16, 1776. Thurman and I had planned to meet in January 1992, however, his death occurred earlier.

In the meantime, my SAR application was approved and I officially became a member of the local SAR Chapter on Dec 5, 1989. Latter this SAR Chapter indicated a desire to honor this Revolutionary War Patriot.

In the spring of 1995, I contacted Thurman Burleson's son, Ronnie Burleson of Richfield, NC who was able to point out the grave site of Isaac Burleson in the Ruben Springer Burial Ground, Stanly County, off of Dusty Road (NC 1226). A publication in the Stanly County Library --Private Cemeteries & Burial Grounds-- confirmed this information and stated, further, he was the first person to be buried at this

location.



I then applied for a headstone through the Department of Veteran Affairs, who confirmed Isaac's Military Service in the Revolutionary War after 184 years. This headstone, complete with lettering, was received from the Georgia Marble Company.

A contact was made with the present owner of this particular property, Dale Burris of Oakboro, NC, who gave permission for this headstone to be installed. At 11:00 AM, May 5, 1995, Ronnie Burleson, my brother Aaron and Gretchen Burleson of Burlington, NC, JD & Karol Burleson, of Thomasville, NC, Thomas N. and Martha Clark, of Burlington, NC, Hoey & Stella Burleson Curlee, and Wilma Burleson Harris of Albemarle, NC, Hazel Burleson and I erected this headstone beside the slate marker, along with the Bronze Patriot Seal.

On May 28, 1995 the SAR Color Guard, dressed in Colonial Uniforms, comprised of Richard J. Moore, E.F. Sharpe, Nat Clark, and myself led the solemn Ceremony. The unveiling of the Marker was by Jerry Burleson and Christopher Burleson --5th & 6th great-grandsons; the laying of the Wreath was by Katie and Daniel

Burleson --6th generation grandchildren. (Randleman, NC)

Others participating in the Dedication were Dr. Charles E. Page, former Chaplain General of the National Society SAR, Mrs. Hazel B. Burleson, Regent of the Battle of Alamance Chapter DAR, Raymond Donnell, President of the Alamance Battleground Chapter SAR, and Thomas N. Clark, President of the NC Society SAR.

Refreshments were served to approximately 80 of the Burleson descendants and SAR participants.





## Hearne-Burleson Home Place



SR 1264 Stanly County R.975.673D

The Hearne-Burleson house provides a rare antebellum example of the Stanly County equivalent of a small planter's house. Since the original owner, Joshua ("Josh") Hearne was aged 47 by the 1850 federal census; the farmhouse could have been built as early as 1825 or 1830. Hearne was the son of Nehemiah Hearne, whose widow Nancy Almond Hearne had donated the acreage for the county seat. Hearne had a substantial farm operation supplemented by the labor of 16 slaves. He also had a gold mine located between his farm and the Albemarle city limits. Hearne and his wife Elizabeth reared eight children in the farmhouse. In the post-Civil War period, widower Hearne moved to Arkansas and left the, farm to his daughter Mary Anne ("Aunt Pig") and her husband Isaac Burleson. In the 1880's Burleson's son Hurley and his wife Lilly Belle took over the farm, which by then consisted of approximately 300 acres. The farm is still in the Burleson family. Descendants of the Hearnes and Burlesons, as well as some of Josh Hearne's slaves, are buried in the family cemetery on the farm.

The one-and-one-half story, side-gabled farmhouse was constructed with heavy timber framing. It follows a traditional hall and parlor plan with an enclosed stair rising to an unceiled loft. By contrast, the interior brick chimney supplying fireplaces to the two downstairs rooms was rare for antebellum houses in Stanly County; most houses had exterior chimneys until the mid-1890's.

The weather boarded dwelling received few changes over the years. It's plain exterior trim features a boxed cornice with pronounced gable end returns; a freizeband; and cornerboards. A shed roof front. porch with chamfered posts wraps around the north side of the house and extends across a side ell added by Hurley Burleson in the late nineteenth century. Four-over-four windows have thinly molded surrounds. The interior retains some of its original woodwork, most notably the hall's plank sheathing and simple Greek Revival mantel. Several deteriorated frame outbuildings remain on the farm: a chickenhouse, a barn, a granary and a workshop.

After Stanley County was formed, the family and heirs of Nehemiah donated 51 acres of land for the new county seat. Therefore, a part of the great Hearne Plantation became the heart of the new town of Albemarle. The first court of the county was held in an upstairs room of the Hearne home. In later years, a bronze marker has been placed to commemorate this site. Nancy, the widow of Nehemiah, was paid \$45.00 over a period of three years for allowing the court to be held in her home.

The Hearne home, call the "Big House" by family members, has a fabulous history. It was built between 1828-1830, as an addition to the original structure constructed by Nehemiah about 1800. Then a separate

section was added in 1841, which was used as offices and rooming quarters for visiting judges and lawyers attending courts, becoming known as the "Hearne Inn", entertaining many notables of the day. It still stands today, as one of the historic landmarks of the city, located about three blocks from the main square on South First Street. From a letter written in 1926 on this, the writer stated:... "Hearne Inn is closed now; the guests have gone; the festal hall is dim; the jesting, toasts, stories, and gay laughter are heard no more. Nothing now but the hush of sleep falls on the empty rooms and halls, but the venerable old Inn remains intact. Proudly it stands like a monument to a noble cause..."

# Helpful Hints To Follow A Family Outline

This book and each of the previous books contains many "Family Outlines" (See \*\*\* Example \*\*\* below). These Family Outlines can be confusing and hard to follow at times. The outlines are printed out by my computer using a program called Family Tree Maker. It is a very good program and has been the central storage location for the BFRG research for 7 years. The Family Tree Maker program keeps each person's name in the right place so we can follow generation after generation. Below is a sample page. It can start with any individual. Each book will be different, but the numbering system is consistent.

Each book starts with the Descendants of the subject of the book and each of their children is listed in small Roman numeral, i.e., i, ii. Each book is divided into chapters, one for each child with descendants. The number to the left of the small Roman numeral is the number for more information on descendants' of that individual. In the sample below number iii, is Jonathan Burleson and the number 2 indicates how to find more information on his descendants. So when you go to number 2, you will find Jonathan Burleson and all of his known children listed the same way. Then you would go to number 7 to find more information on Dennis Clay Burleson's descendants. You can follow this numbering system all the way through the book. If there is no number to the right of a individual, such as i. Thomas Burleson that means that Thomas Burleson has no known children and that will be all the information listed for him. According to how large the generation is you may have to go several pages to find the next number.



# ISAAC BURLESON: Company C 42nd North Carolina Hoke's Brigade 1842 - 1910

Isaac was the third son of William "Billie" and Sarah Harwood Burleyson of Little Bear Creek in Stanly County. He enlisted into the Confederate Army on February 1, 1862. His service started as a prison guard at Salisbury and ended at Bennett's Place in May 1865. This included service with the Army of Northern Virginia.

The 42nd saw action in the Eastern part of North Carolina in 1862 and 1863. In 1864 the 42nd, Hoke's Brigade, was sent to defend Richmond. General Grant suffered greatly in his attack at Cold Harbor against Hoke's Brigade.

The 42nd was positioned in the center and all other regiments were aligned to the left and right of the 42nd at Bentonville. This was the very last battle to stop Sherman's much larger army.

Isaac gave his service in full measure from February 1862 until the final Confederate surrender and the disbanding of the 42nd on May 2, 1865 at Center Church in Randolph County.

Isaac returned to Stanly County after the war to marry Mary Hearne and there they raised their family and helped to rebuild their community. Today they lay in rest in the family graveyard on Burleson Road.



Everyone who remembers Hurley Burleson says that Family Reunions and family get-togethers are what Hurley loved. When talking with several members of this family they all say the same thing, Hurley always wanted the family to get together for food and fellowship. Miss Lena told several different stories of these family get-togethers and what they meant to her and her family. Here is what Hilda shared at the BFRG's reunion last year about their family.

#### **Burleson Gatherings**

Grandpa Hurley liked for the family to gather, He planned meals with children and grandchildren as often as he could. One Thanksgiving was memorable. We got out of school the day before Thanksgiving at noon. Grandpa had all parents who could gather to prepare a Thanksgiving lunch which was ready when we got off the school bus. What a feast and what good memories! I'll never forget the aroma of that meal.

#### Keeping Traditions Alive

Thurman attempted to keep the family gatherings alive after Grandpa Hurley died. I remember one in particular. It was during the war years and our mom had begun public work and needed all her time at home on weekends. Thurman planned a picnic at Morrow Mountain State Park for Sunday for all the families. Mama maintained all week that we would not be able to go. Of course we were especially good and kept dropping hints and hoping. As late as Saturday evening the prospects of going were slim. But when we got up on Sunday morning to do our chores, we found that Mama had woke up early, had gone to Uncle Newt, who opened his store next door, and had brought enough picnic food for us to go on the outing. The photos of that outing helped us relive the fun and remember the good times we had.

The BFRG was fortunate enough to be invited to the *Descendants of Hurley Burleson Family Reunion* on June 01, 2003. There were about 75 people present and they are still carrying on the family traditions of having family reunions that Hurley started over 100 years ago. This tradition was continued by Ronnie's father, Thurman. (For a tribute to Thurman for all his work on Burleson Genealogy, see page 11 of the *Recollections*). Several people brought pictures to share. Ronnie Burleson brought a slide projector and many older slides that were taken by his father, Thurman, during the 1950' and 1960's of family reunions.

Thurman is the baby being held by Tebe standing behind the child with the bonnet on. Tebe died in child birth in 1920. Based on some of the children who are identified, Margaret Lee Burleson and Marvin (Jack) Burleson, this picture was probably taken in 1919. Brady Burleson was in the military and Thurman was raised by Hurley as his own. My great-grandfather, Ebin Burleson, is seated in the front row holding the child who is wearing a bonnet (Marvin).



Grandma and Dora Burleson made this salve during the season when the saps could be gathered. They kept a supply on hand and supplied the neighborhood with portions. 



### Queen of the kitchen

After 41 years of cooking the Family Night at First Baptist Church Ruth Elliott cooks her last supper.

Ummmm! You know it's country style steak night when you hit the parking lot. Or when you head down the hall toward the office. It's all you can do not to follow your nose right into the kitchen and peek into the pot. Wednesday is family night at First Baptist Church, and by 5:30 the line is long and mouths are watering for Ruth Elliott's country style steak and mashed potatoes and gray, salad bar, and hot rolls. Hot rolls? She reaches into the oven and takes out a dozen rolls she's preparing for a take-out order - and drops them. Plop! Right in the middle of the floor. No worry about the rolls. She's got plenty more. But this is the first time in the 41 years Miss Ruth has been queen of the kitchen at First Baptist that she's ever

dropped anything. Maybe it's a sign. This day is different from all the other days. It's Miss Ruth's last. She won't be calling Albemarle today or tomorrow to get her chicken order in for nest Wednesday night or going to Food Lion Tuesday morning to pick up the rest of her groceries and kid around a little with the cashiers. They beg her to put all her recipes in a book so they can buy it.

She won't be in the church kitchen by 7:15 next Wednesday morning. OK, so 7:15 is an early starting time for a 5:30 supper but frying steak for 300 people, give or take a few, takes time. And she doesn't drive. Her husband. Sam, who always took her every where, died almost two years ago. Now her daughter-in-law, Dee, takes her to work as she goes herself, and Dee's a teacher. So Miss Ruth starts early. Or did. She won't have to next week. Phyllis Ohm, who's been helping her for several years now and knows all the secrets that Miss Ruth has never kept secret, will be ordering the meat and picking up the groceries next week. "But I'm not going to tell'em goodbye," Miss Ruth says, coating another piece of steak with flour. "I'm going to volunteer to pour tea next week, so I can talk to everybody." Not to spend hours making sure the seasoning is just right and turning steak in the big iron pan and loving every minute of it because she knows the eaters are going to love every bite. "This is one of their favorite meals," she says. "I think I could fry chicken one week and steak the next and they'd be happy." Especially if dessert is chocolate cake with chocolate icing. But she likes to mix the menu up a little, so the Baptists have meat loaf nights and spaghetti nights and chicken pot pie and beef stew nights and coconut and lemon cheese pies, and they eat it all. So why did she decide to retire?

"It wasn't easy," she admits. But she's 79 years old, and after 41 years as church hostess, she knows it's time. "I've got arthritis so bad in the knees and I'm afraid I'll fall." And if she falls, she could end up in a nursing home like her sister, Gertie Burleson, did, and she doesn't want that to happen. "So I cried, and I prayed," she says, "and I prayed and I cried." And finally she knew what the decision had to be. She'd retire and become a volunteer and let someone else be responsible for getting everything ordered and prepared and served and cleaned up after 250-300 eat their fill. It is fitting. She started as a volunteer.

#### Moved from Charlotte

Mrs. C.P. Mulder was church hostess when she and Sam and their two children moved here from Charlotte because of Robie Nash. Sam was a wheel alignment man, and Robie Nash had an automobile agency and a garage. "And Robie's daddy and my daddy were first cousins," she says, "so Robie came to Charlotte to get Sam to work for him when Raymond was only six weeks old" and their daughter, Charles Carolyn, was a few years older. "We moved, and the second week we lived here Maxine Carlton and Molly Moore came over and enrolled my son in the cradle roll at church, and we started coming to First Baptist and I started cooking." It was as simple as that.

She learned to cook from her mother and both her grandmothers. They all cooked by instinct. "And they were all excellent cooks," she says. She likes to read recipes and she uses them - but she changes them when she wants to. When she started volunteering. First Baptist was on the corner of Church and Liberty. When the present church was built, Mrs. Mulder decided to quit and the Rev. Archie Ellis asked Miss Ruth to be the hostess at the new church. And it's been her joy ever since.

#### 'A little extra'

"I've always had good help," she says. And it's not hard to find out what people like (First Baptists like limas better than sugar peas) or cater to people who need something special. When she makes potato salad, she takes out some for those who can't eat onions before she puts the onions in. And she fixes chicken without salt for people who can't eat salt. "It don't take much to do a little extra," she says. That pleases the members. And pleasing them pleases her. Like it always pleased her to watch people eat the angel biscuits she used to make. They couldn't get enough of those biscuits. One night when she was leaving a little boy asked her if she carried any of those angel biscuits in her pocketbook. No, not in her pocketbook, she told him, but she had some in the kitchen and she fixed a bag for him. Nora Poole used to say if Miss Ruth went first she'd look at her hands and just wonder how many angel biscuits she'd made in her life.


She started them as an experiment, and everybody liked them so much she served them with everything until the doctor told her she'd have to stop making bread. But she didn't worry about that. She just bought rolls and they're good, too. She's never worried about hercooking. Cooking's like growing flowers," she said once long ago. "You have to talk to it. But I don't ever worry about it."

Not in the early days of the new church when the temperature rested in the 90s and there was no air conditioning, or now when people forget to make reservations or make them and don't come. It all evens out.

Just like she's not worrying about retiring. Well, not much.

#### Hates to leave

Wednesday night, handing out the silver, she admits that deep down in her heart she's thinking somebody else will be doing this next week. But she doesn't talk about it. Instead she smiles. "I love it," she says, "and I just hate to leave it so bad. But I'm not going to sit down and do nothing." She's already got an order to fill for someone tomorrow at home.





## Ronnie Remembers "Pa and Ma"

Thurman had many fond memories and told many stories of "Pa" and "Ma" (Hurley and Lillie). I was too young and uninterested at the time to remember many details. I do know that they enjoyed family and community get-togethers, particularly special occasions. Thurman also continued to celebrate in traditional fashion,



especially on Christmas and Easter family gatherings with

as many as could come, and all were expected to come. He was instrumental in getting the Hurley Burleson reunion tradition started. He felt strongly that family was important and supportive as well as celebrating and commemorating our ancestors. As with gatherings at "Pa's," there were always gatherings at Thurman and Mary Jewel's. Mary Jewel, being an excellent cook, always had plenty of food for whatever the occasion, whether it was a supper for ten to twenty close friends or the "happened to come by" around lunchtime by the county extension agent, pastor, or local farm supply salesman. Thurman liked his desserts so there was always pie, cake, or persimmon pudding as well as homemade biscuits for the molasses or honey. One traditional food for Easter was roe (female) shad – something Hurley always did. Seining and fish fries always took place during the summer.

Like Hurley, Thurman loved, not only celebrating family and tradition, but he also looked forward to change. Growing up on the farm and observing Hurley's leadership and farming skills, Thurman also wanted to farm like some of Hurley's other children. Thurman worked for several years as an electrician and farmed at the same time. After having traded farms among family members and buying other farms in the Burleson Road community, Thurman bought a larger farm on Kendalls Church Road in 1947 and moved away from the home place. Thurman's business skills and strong work ethic ensured the farm's prosperity. He was known as a progressive farmer, staying on the cutting edge of new technology and leading the farm community into the future. He helped his sons, Ronnie and Dennis, become farming partners, and they, in turn, helped their sons, Andrew and Aaron, become part of the family business known as Thurman Burleson and Sons Farm, one of the largest farms in Stanly County. Thurman was the only farmer in the community to own a hay baler, the first to have a four row planter, and the first to buy a self-propelled combine. Thurman encouraged his family to explore and try new things. This led the partnership to venture into growing cotton again in 1991 after the boll weevil forced him to quit growing cotton in 1948. This new venture proved to be a good decision for the farm, and Thurman was proud to see progressive farming continue. He died after that year's harvest. Thurman's encouragement and leadership as well as his example led us to build a family owned cotton gin.

I am proud to call myself a Burleson. We can all see family traits passed down through the generations as the family continues to celebrate traditions. I now wish I had paid more attention to the stories being told in the past so that I could better understand our ancestors. We should all be proud of our faith, commitment, resemblances, forethought, leadership, strong personalities, and sometimes even our bullheadedness. I am sure that even back in the Revolutionary War these and other traits were in Burlesons.


A business woman, farmer, dairyman and poultry farmer, she was born April 30, 1904, at the Lowder homeplace off the Concord Road, the oldest of, seven children. She lived with and cared for her aging grandparents until their deaths. During this time she absorbed good reading materials, excelled in school and developed a sense of history and pride in her heritage. Events and people of the time made a deep impression on her and school, although a long walk, was a joy.

Her great-grandfather gave the three acres of land for Friendship Methodist Church and it was here she joined family members in singing. Her uncles played in the band from the area and at one time, she could play a violin, piano, organ and strum a guitar.

In 1922 she married Klon Roy Burleson and moved to the home on Burleson Road, becoming a member of Pine Grove Methodist Church. In 1928 her husband became ill with Hodgkins disease. When he died in 1936 she had five children and was expecting her sixth.

Refusing to place any of her children in an orphanage or let family members take one or more of them, she set about to do what she knew to support them, farming. She raised chickens and sold eggs, milk and butter to support her family.

Her workday averaged 18 hours. After dark and with the chores done, she made butter, preserved the food of the season and made clothes for herself and her children. She was barber to her sons, the neighbors and nearby relatives. Over the years her children grew up and her sons served in the military. All settled not too far from her.

Baseball in the Fifties—A Far Cry from 2003

Leon grew up on a farm in Stanly County on Lake Tillery. He

developed a skill in baseball and played on the American Legion teams locally. In high school his principal recognized his ability and helped attract the attention of a Cincinnati Reds scout. Leon was known for his control and fast ball. He signed a Class A contract with a very modest bonus and reported to Columbia SC the spring following high school graduation.

He played for two years in the Columbia area and on Reds' farm teams in Utah, Idaho, and Montana. Back in Columbia in '52, the team won the Sally League pennant and each player's contract was sent up to the Tulsa, Oklahoma team which was AA level. Because the Reds had no AAA teams, the next level would be the majors.

During that season, Leon had become more and more aware of the lack of future some of the aging players faced. Many of them tried to function with families accompanying them or left behind. They could not have a "real" job back home, because they reported to spring training by late February or March, and the season lasted until well into the fall, especially if your team was winning.

There were also several bonus pitchers on the roster who "had" to be played, so all pitchers' records began to be affected. Leon's record was taking a beating, and he began to like professional baseball less.

A particular incident helped him to see how vulnerable the players were and also how little they were needed after being injured. The team's top-notch catcher was injured and had no choice but to take a job driving a local garbage truck while recovering. Instead of support, the management found the situation laughable.

The following spring the Tulsa contract came. Leon kept it. His scout called and came, but Leon had really ended his professional career the year before. It had been fun and glamorous, but the glory was short-lived. He always felt he made a wise decision. He did continue semipro and Army baseball and after college helped coach baseball and basketball at the junior high level. To him, that was baseball in the real world.
