1. DAVID<sup>1</sup> BURLESON was born 1755 in VA OR NC BFB PG 98, and died August 13, 1832 in FAMILY CEM MURFREESBORO TN RUTHERFORD CO TN. He married URSULA WEATHERFORD 1773 in NC. She was born 1755 in MONTGOMERY CO NC (NOW STANLY), and died February 27, 1835 in FAMILY CEM MURFREESBORO TN RUTHERFORD CO TN.

GENEALOGY - David Burleson 1755-1832

David BURLESON/BURLEYSON/BURLASON was the ancestor of a large group of southern BURLFSON families. The name of his father is not known, although tradition states that David was the son of John, son of Aaron I, and that John was killed during the American Revolution. Another tradition states that Aaron I had a son Daniel or David, who was believed killed in the Revolution. We do know that both a John and a Jonathan BURLESON were counted in the tax lists of Lunenburg County, Virginia, between 1748 and 1752, as listed by Landon C. Bell in Sunlight on the Southside, Lists of Tithes of Lunenburg County, Virginia 1748-1783, pages 84, 101, and 205,

According to the ages listed in the U.S. census records of 1790, (16+), 1800, (45+), 1810, (45+), and 1830 (70-80), David's birthdate can be estimated as occurring no later than 1755. Census records of the same area also show the name of Isaac BURLESON, born by 1755, and believed to be the brother of David. See the census records in this issue.

David BURLESON served in the American Revolution as a private with Major James FARRIS's Battalion, Colonel WADE's Regiment, as attested to by his original discharge paper, which belonged to Dr. Haskell BURLESON TALLEY. Dr. TALLEY, who died in 1963, was a descendant of David through the marriage of David's grand-daughter, Kate Augusta BURLESON, and Edwin Wells TALLEY. The discharge reads as follows:

"This is to certify that David BURLESON served a three months Tour under me in Col, Wades Regiment and is discharge by me October 9th 1782 James Farris, Major"

Dr, TALLEY also had in his possession's paper attesting to the fact that David BURLESON took the oath of allegiance to the Patriotic government in Anson County, North Carolina, on May 28, 1778. Copies of some of Dr. TALLEY's material are held by various members of BFA, but the location of his original papers is not presently known. A Government marker was placed on David's grave in Rutherford County, Tennessee, by the Capt. Wm. LYTLE Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution. David BURLISDN received North Carolina pay vouchers #1013, (perhaps #1613, see Figure 7), dated 25 October 1782, and #1887, dated 30 August 1784 (Fig.6 ), In the Revolutionary Army Accounts, Volume XI, page 55, Folio 3, the Certificate number is given as #1613; this appears to be a reference to a voucher number, and is possibly the same voucher as #1013, These vouchers were issued in the Salisbury District of North Carolina, which included the present counties of Anson and Montgomery.

David BURLYSSON received a grant of 100 acres in Anson County North Carolina, This grant was numbered 572, File 4412, and was issued on 14 November 1783, the entry was made 12 May 1779, and the land was surveyed on the northwest side of Richardson's Creek, One of the chain carriers was Hilkieh WEATHERFORD. See the land records printed in this issue. David received additional grants of land in North Carolina, according to records in May Wills McBee's Anson County, North Carolina: Abstracts of Early Records (1959, Rpt. Baltimore: Genealogical Publishing Co., 1980), p, 4, Copies of these additional grants have been requested from the Secretary of State at Raleigh, North Carolina.

David's marriage probably occurred about 1773 or 1774, as his son John was born 3 September 1775, David's wife was Ursula; it is believed that her last name was WEATHERFORD, although the name of BROOKS has also been suggested. It is known that a Hilkieh WEATHERFORD lived near David in Montgomery County, North Carolina, in the early 1800's (1800 census, page 511/509) and that one of the sons of David was named Hilkieh.

David and Ursula BURLESON had at least 11 children. See the family sheet printed herein for names and other information on these children. The family appears to have remained in Anson and Montgomery Counties, North Carolina, until shortly before 1810, when they were enumerated in tax and census records of Rutherford County, Tennessee. Moses BURLISON, son of David, made a deed in Rutherford County in 1808, when he bought 127 acres on the waters of Stewarts Creek of Stones River (Deed Bk. K, p. 243). David BURLISON, 5R. sold land to his son, Hilkieh BURLISON in 1814 (Deed Bk. M, p. 12) and signed the deed with his mark. David's line adjoined that of Mourning HOBSON. We have references to an 1812 deed between David BURLESON and Mourning/Morning HOBSON, when David is reported to have bought 100 acres for \$400. However, this deed record cannot now be located.

See the census records printed herein for the family of David BURLESON. I have not found a census record of David in 1820. He was, perhaps, living with one of his children. The 1830 census of Rutherford County appears to list David and his wife with the family of Isaac BURLESON, who is shown with an older man and woman who are both aged 70-80.

David died in Rutherford County 13 August 1832 (from tombstone); his wife Ursula died 27 February 1835. David is buried in the old family graveyard which is located near Murfreesboro. We assume that Ursula is buried there with no marker, as there are several unmarked graves. See the pictures of the grave and homesite in this issue. David BURLASON made his will in Rutherford County on 18 February 1828, and it was probated there 12 November 1832. It is recorded in Will Book 8, pages 499-500, and is printed in the Probate column in this issue.

Of David's children, John moved to Alabama and appeared on the 1830 census of Marion County. Moses and Edy went to Jefferson County, Alabama, and McNairy County, Tennessee. Make note that it was not this Moses, son of David, who was in the Warren County, Tennessee records and died there in 1828. Mary BURLESON BROOKS and her family lived in Union County, North Carolina. David and Sarah moved to Texas about 1847 and settled in Leon County. William's wife is unknown; it is believed that he remained in Tennessee, as some of his children left records in Lawrence County, Tennessee. Sarah BURLESON ROWLAND was believed to have lived in Cabarrus County, North Carolina, about 1820-1830, but BFA has no further records of her. Eleanor BURLESON ROWLAND lived in Tippah County, Mississippi. Hilkiyah moved to Marion County, Alabama, and there is deed evidence that Ursula BURLESON SELF also lived in Marion County. We do not know anything more of Margaret and Ezekial POPE.. David's son Isaac remained in Rutherford County, Tennessee, and is buried in the family graveyard.

It is hoped that further research in the North Carolina records will reveal proof of the parentage of David BURLESON, whom we designate as David Sr. At this time BFA has 40 members who descend from David BURLESON, Sr.

Thanks to all of you who have contributed your records and research time, making it possible for BFA to document this family.

## David Burleson

David has been pretty well documented; starting from the Oath of the Allegiance he took in 1778.

I doubt if he was forced to submit to Whig authority as many in Anson and Mecklenburg counties were. The military, both Torie and Whig, would roam the countryside and pressure the inhabitants into submission; often they would hang a few if they switched sides.

Dr. Bruce Pruitt is the author of many books, including Abstract of Deed and Record of Anson County, NC. He assured me that in Anson County, during the war, the county government was controlled by the Whigs. An oath was required as the first step to obtain a deed.

They did that to exclude any Tory from obtaining property in Anson, and most Tory land was confiscated after the war.

David's first grant was completed in January 1779. He was granted several tracks, all on Richardson Creek and would be in Union County today, and still owned land in Anson in 1785. It has

been reported that he went to TN after the war but had to return to NC because of the Indians. I believe he sold his Anson Property prior to going to TN. He is living in Montgomery/Stanly County in the 1790 and 1800 census next to his son in law, William Brooks.

It is my belief that David and Isaac were brothers. In a correspondence to her father, David's daughter Sara Rowland's letter of Jan. 1826 states: "Old Aunt Martha is still living at her old home place and her youngest son lives with her and is single."

She was referring to Martha Clay, the wife of Isaac, and their youngest son Joseph b. 1805. Joseph apparently inherited the property of his father because he was the caretaker of his widowed mother. When Joseph died, his estate was settled on 1 Sept 1852 by his oldest son. The estate sold 3 tracks of land. No. 2 track was described as 130 acres, called the "Patty Burleson Place." (Patty is short for Martha.) No. 3 track was 173 acres, called the "David Burleson Place."

To me this shows that Isaac bought the 173 acres from David when David left for Rutherford Co, TN, around 1806.

The naming pattern is similar with Isaac and David's children. It appears that Isaac, Moses, David and the husband of Agnes Weatherford are all in the 14<sup>th</sup> Militia District Mecklenburg County, NC from 1774 to 1776. DNA will show what the relationships of these four Burleson are, but in another letter from Hill K (son of David and Ursula) to his parents, he definitely knew his kin. Hill K states, "I rented a piece of ground from cousin Joseph Burleson." (Son of Aaron and Rachel Hendricks Burleson). Both Hill K and David knew if Joseph was a 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> cousin to David or Hill K.

Remember the January 1763 Anson County deed witnessed by Aaron Burlison and William Brooks? This places Hill K's grandfather, William Brooks Sr., with Joseph's father Aaron Burleson together on Richardson Creek.

David was a Revolutionary War soldier, serving in the company of Capt. James Farris Anson Co. Militia Company Col. Thomas Wade regiment. Col. Wade regiment took part in the Battle of Moores Creek Bridge in 1776. David may well have been a member at that time.

At the war's end in 1782, North Carolina set up a commission to honor the Soldiers Vouchers in land instead of money. Isaac took his in Montgomery Co, on Little Bear Creek in 1782, Jessie took his in Effingham Co, GA, 1785, and David took his in the 1<sup>st</sup> Military District of NC, which became Davidson Co, NC. Still later this became Rutherford County, TN after 1792.

In Dec 1783, Col William Polk arrived in Nashville as the Surveyor General for the Cumberland Basin, the territory now known as middle TN. He was responsible for assigning all land and issuing all deeds. He was accompanied by his uncle Ezekial Polk, who served as a surveyor. Another uncle, Capt. Charles Polk of Clear Creek, pension record states that he moved his family to TN but returned to Clear Creek a short time later because of Indian predation

David moved his family to Tennessee and returned to Montgomery county. It is very possible these two families traveled together. David and Ursula Weatherford Burleson and the Polks are linked several ways:

- David's daughter Mary married William Brooks II.
- William Brooks II brother John married the daughter of Captain Charles Polk.
- William Brooks II and wife Mary Burleson's daughter Sarah married Thomas Polk Jr., son of Col. Thomas Polk and wife Mary Shelby.
- Col. Thomas second wife was 17 year old Waxhaw Indian maiden named Keziah Tarleton. His father was Col. William Polk, a brother to Capt. Charles Polk
- Col. William's first wife was Cynthia Spratt, daughter of the first settler in Mecklenburg County, Thomas Spratt. Col. William's second wife was a Sarah Weatherford.
- William and Sarah Weatherford Polk's daughter, Margaret Ann, married William Weatherford, son of Wilkerson Weatherford.

- Another daughter, Nancy, married Isaac Shelby, son of Rees Shelby, the brother of General Isaac Shelby, governor of Kentucky.
- William Brooks II and wife Mary Burleson's son Davidson married Keziah Tarleton Polk, the 18 year-old widow and 2nd wife of Col. Thomas Polk.

When I first started my research on the Burleson Family I met Helen Garner in the Heritage Room of the Stanly County Library. She was a volunteer at the Library and I noticed that everyone who came in wanted to ask her questions and talk with her about their genealogical research. It was very interesting and I just listened as she talked about the early families of Stanly County. I remember that first encounter. I guess she was in her late 70's and about 3:00 o'clock she said, "I have to leave now and go pick up my mother". In future meetings with Helen I learned that she descended from David Burleson thru his daughter, Sarah, who married Sherwood Rowland. Sarah was one of David's daughters who remained in Stanly County. While working on our next book, I found an old file of papers I had received from Helen. Going thru them I found a great deal of stories and information to use in our book. Here is one story; I hope you find it as interesting as I did.

*"John A. Rowland was killed at Petersburg, Va. Thomas Rowland and Daniel Lefler were to go for his body on August 28, 1862, to Petersburg. Daniel didn't go. Thomas Rowland and Eve Caroline Hahn Rowland (John A Rowland's widow) went to Raleigh for the body on the train. On the way back the train wrecked, Thomas Rowland was killed. Caroline was fatally injured. John and Caroline's daughter, Louisy Jane fell of the porch while her mother was gone, injured her head and never recovered. She died in December of 1862. This story told to me (Helen Garner) by Ransom Lipe, grandson of uncle Gip, Homer Hatley, nephew of uncle Gip, and Gurley Hatley, grandson of Uncle Gip, in 1974. Uncle Gip, is Guilford Hatley, husband of Ann Elizabeth Rowland, daughter of Thomas Rowland and brother-in-law to John A. Rowland. The Rowland family cemetery is located in a pasture out from the home of Ulysses and Isabel Hatley - old home place of Thomas Rowland".*

Thomas was the oldest son of Sherwood and Sarah Burleson Rowland.

This is a letter from William S. Burleson. He included it in his book about the Burleson Family, *The Family of Frances Marie Brown and William S. Burleson*. William (Bill) began the letter with the greeting, "Dear Cousins," because he felt that all Burlesons have common ancestry and are kin and cousins. Unfortunately I never got to meet Bill. When I began researching my ancestors I discovered the Burleson Family Association. I tried to contact Bill, and his wife told me that he had passed away. She was very helpful and gave me many copies of the Burleson Family Association's Bulletins and a copy of his book.

I urge all of us to read this letter and follow his suggestions; take time to write down and record our family history. As he said in the letter, "If you take the time to record your family's history, your descendants will bless you for generations in the future".

Dear Cousins,

During the years I have been studying the Burleson Family; many times I have reached a dead end because no record of a particular family was available. If only some member of that family had gone to the trouble to write down a few statistics, their descendants would hold them in high esteem. Family research is a most interesting and gratifying hobby when the pieces of the puzzle are available, but it can also be frustrating when you are unable to locate one or more of the pieces. Following the migration trails of our ancestors led to many exciting tales when they left an account of their lives.

It is possible to reconstruct many families who lived in America from 1850 to 1910, by locating the Federal Census records of the state and county in which they lived. Beginning in 1850, the census record gives the names and ages of each member of a family, as well as their occupation and the state in which they were born. Prior to 1850, only name of the head of each household was given with number of males and females in several age groups. If they can be found in the census after 1850, members of a family can be identified, but that information is not enough. It does not tell us anything about the people, what they looked like, what they achieved, where they failed, marriages, deaths, divorces, military service, business success and failure, religion or education.

How I would like to know the details of the life of our ancestor, Aaron Burleson, who migrated from Virginia to Georgia in 1757 and lived through most of the Revolutionary War! Who was his first wife, at what age did he marry Patty Wilder, what did his home on the Savannah River look like, was he successful at farming, was he slim or fat, how tall and did he die in 1783? I don't even know the names of his parents, brothers and sisters. It would be like finding a treasure for me to locate a diary or old letters which would give us some insight into his life during those troubled times when our nation was undergoing the rigors of birth.

It is more than likely, that one of your descendants will want to know about your family. Old Aaron of Georgia had an excuse for not leaving records. He was so busy trying to stay alive and protect his family; he had little time for much else. There is no excuse today for failing to leave this type of information to our children, and their children. My Dad, Eben L. Burleson, left me with enough records to get started on my research, and I am glad I can pass that on, along with the additional history and genealogy located since he died. The establishment of Burleson Family Association in 1981 has brought together the combined records of its members and greatly enhanced our knowledge of the Burleson Family.

If you will take the time to record your family's history, your descendants will bless you for generations in the future.

DAVID BURLESON PGS #221

By William S. Burleson

David Was born ca 1755 and since I am not sure who his father was, I don't know where he was born. In about 1773, he married Ursula WEATHERFORD, probably in the part of Anson County, NC which became Montgomery County in 1779. He died 13 Aug. 1832, Ursula, 27 Feb. 1835, in Rutherford County, TN. According to family tradition, David was son of John BURLESON. John is also thought to be father of Isaac BURLESON, who lived in Montgomery County, NC. He may have been the John who was in Lunenburg County, VA 1748-52, then Bedford Co., VA. Ursula's parents are also unknown, but Hilkiah WEATHERFORD is near David in the 1800 census of Montgomery Co., NC (pg 511/509), probably Ursula's brother. David and Ursula had eleven children:

- #2211 John Washington, b. 3 Sep. 1775 NC, m. Mary McGEHEE ca 1794, d. 25 Apr. 1845 Marion Co. AL. Had 9 or 10 children.
- #2212 Moses, b. ca 1776 NC, m. Edy HOBSON ca 1795, d. 27 Mar. 1836 Franklin Co., AL. They had nine children and 5 or 6 moved to Texas.
- #2213 Mary, b. ca 1780, m. William BROOKS II ca 1801, d. 1852 Union Co., NC. They had eleven children.
- #2214 David Jr., b. 17 Aug. 1786 NC, m. Sarah HOBSON 1805 NC, d. 8 Apr. 1856 Leon Co., TX. Had ten children. All died in Texas.
- #2215 William, b. ca 1786 NC, m. Sarah (?SELF), d. after 1857 Lawrence Co. TN. They had five children. James A. 1808-1873 d. TX.
- #2216 Sarah, b. ca 1788 NC, m. Sherwood ROWLAND. Lived Cabarrus Co., NC.
- #2217 Elinor "Nelly", b. 1 Jan. 1789 NC, m. William Thomas ROWLAND ca 1810, d. 9 Apr 1870 Tippah Co., MS. Had 9 children. Moved to MS. 1838.

#2218 Hilkih, b. ca 1790 NC, m. (1) Penelope POPE 1810 TN., (2) Sarah McGUIRE, d. 1855-60 Marion Co., AL. Had 27 children per descendants.

#2219 Margaret, b. ca 1791 NC. M. Ezekiel POPE 1810 TN., d. 1 Jan. 1839 in either Williamson or Weakley Co., TN. Had eight children.

#221A Ursula, b. ca 1798 TN, m. Nathan SELF 1816 TN. Had ten children.

#221B Isaac, b. 17 Oct. 1795 NC, m. (1) Frances S. MORTON 1818 TN. (2) Julia BONNER 1856 TN. D. 24 Jan 1865 Rutherford Co. TN. Had eleven children.

David Burleson served in the North Carolina Militia in the American Revolution with Maj. James FARRIS' Battalion, Colonel WADE's Regiment (BFB pg. 100). They moved from Montgomery County, NC. To Rutherford County, TN. in 1805 or 1806, where most of their children were married. By 1818 the children began to move away from Rutherford Co., TN. John #2211, Moses #2212 and David Jr. #2214, went to the area of Alabama where Blount, St. Clair and Jefferson Counties converge. The Blount County deed records for 1818 through 1829 were lost. Only the Land Tract book was preserved, and the following names were written on it in Township 14, Range 1W; Section 27 David BURLESON 1819, Section 31 William BURLESON 1826 ( Son of Moses). David's land was in southeastern Blount County, William's land was in Jefferson County and David's brother, John, was nearby in St. Clair County, Twp. 13, Range 1W, Sec. 20 (Land Grant 14 Nov. 1821).

Many of their children married in Blount and Jefferson Counties from 1818 to 1825. In about 1826 or 27, Moses moved back to Tennessee, to McNairy County where his brother, William #2215, was living. Moses, son Michael and William appear is the 1830 census of McNairy Co. TN. (BFB pg. 1001). John #2211, David Jr. #2214, Nathan and Ursula SELF #221A, moved to Marion Co., AL about the same time. Whether or not Hilkih #2218, was with his older brothers in Blount County, AL. is not known, for he first appears in Marion County, AL. in about 1826. There is some indication Hilkih lived in Lawrence County, AL., on land owned by Joseph BURLESON (#216), prior to that. Moses moved to Franklin County, AL. later.

Mary BURLESON BROOKS and her family lived in Union County, NC. William and Isaac remained in TN. Sarah BURLESON ROWLAND lived in Cabarrus County, NC. Eleanor BURLESON ROWLAND and her family move to Tippah County, MS. During the 1850's, many of the descendants of John, Moses, David Jr., and Ursula SELF went to Texas. Descendants of Isaac #221B, remained in Rutherford Co., TN.

They were a close family and being literate they kept in touch by writing to their parents and to each other. Six of the letters dated from 1818 to 1831, have been preserved and are reproduced in BFB pgs. 529, 530 and 1011. Dr. Haskell Burleson TALLEY 1877-1963, David's great grandson, had many of David's papers, including his discharge dated 1782. BFA member, Herschell Burleson TALLEY of Crete, Nebraska is believed to be the present owner of these valuable old documents.

During the 1940's, Dr. Woody WERKING visited Dr. Haskell Burleson TALLY in Murfreesboro, TN. and recorded all he had to say about David BURLESON. Dr. Werking wrote the LIFE OF DAVID BURLESON SR., following that visit, most of which is quoted below. I have added footnotes to explain or correct some of his information. My remarks are in <> brackets, or the passage to which a footnote applies is identified with a number within <> brackets.

LIFE OF DAVID BURLESON SR., OF RUTHERFORD CO., TENN. Compiled by Burleson Genealogist Dr. F. Woody Werking. (Pages 804-814 Edna Lewis Boyd)

“ The earliest documentary record that we have of David Burleson Sr., is that of a paper in the possession of Dr. Haskell Burleson Talley, retired attorney of near Murfreesboro in Rutherford Co., Tenn. And great-grandson of David; attesting to the fact that David Burleson took the oath of Allegiance to the Patriotic Government in Anson Co., N.C. on May 28, 1778. From that date we gather that he was born in or before 1757. Dr. Tally also owns the original discharge paper of David which reads as follows: ‘This may certify that David Burleson Served a three months tour of duty under me in Col. Wades Regiment, and is discharged by me October the 9<sup>th</sup> 1782.

James Farris, Major’

“ Dr. Talley believes that it was shortly after his military discharge that David Burleson first went to Rutherford Co., Tenn., viz., about 1783 and built his log cabin on Stone River, a good part of which is still preserved by Dr. Talley in dismantled condition. There is no reason to believe that a single nail was used in its construction, as even the shingles had pegs in them. In fashioning the door latch, an ingeniously devised wooden spring was used. The enormous metal was kettle is still at the old homestead site, enjoying a long and no doubt well earned rest. That first wilderness home was broken up about 1785 by ever-increasing Indian depredations on the Stone River.

“ It was probably about that time that my own great-great-great grandfather Aaron Burleson III, perhaps a first cousin of David was killed by the Indians and Aaron’s sister, Mary Burleson McFadden, lost her husband in an Indian massacre on Stone River, where she herself was scalped and left for dead. As a result of this bloody episode, some of Aaron III’s brothers retreated to the region of Rutherford Co., N.C. and David went back to Montgomery Co., N.C. region where we find him in the 1790 census as follows:

David Burleson 2 males 16 or over  
2 “ under 16  
5 females of all ages.

“ I believe that David was likely a brother of Isaac, the only other Burleson family head listed in that county in that census, in fact right next to David, namely:

Isaac Burleson 1 male 16 or over  
2 “ under 16  
3 females of all ages.

“ I also believe that this is the Isaac Burleson who, according to D.A.R. Roster of Soldiers in the Revolution from N.C. served in Captain Charles Polk’s Co., of Militia Foot Soldiers in N.C. (as a private, pp. 489, 490, 491, 493, 494). There is also reason to believe that Moses Burleson, progenitor of hundreds of Burleson descendants living today in Stanly and Cabarrus Counties in N.C., was also a brother of David. <1>

“ We may assume from the above census record that David had a son at least 16 years old. That would put David’s marriage about 1773 and his birth about 1752, probably in Lunenburg Co., VA. In Landon C. Bell’s helpful work ‘Sunlight on the South Side’, we find the list of Tithes of Lunenburg Co., Va. 1748-1783 in which the Burlesons are recorded as follows: Aaron, John and Jonathan 1748-1752.

“ Our first records of Burlesons in N.C. are of the date 1763 when the names of Aaron and James Burleson appear on Land Grants in Cumberland Co., N.C. That was also, according to family tradition the date of the death of Aaron. David Burleson Sr., does not name an Aaron among the sons in his Will, but that does not eliminate the possibility that he had at that time a deceased son of that name. We do find the name given to one or more of David’s grandchildren.

“ David named his wife Ursula in his Will. They had a son Hill K or Hilkiah. David’s daughter Sarah Burleson Rowland refers in a letter written in 1831 to her parents, to her “old Uncle Hill Weatherford & Uncle Billy Weatherford”. This leads me to assume that her mother’s maiden name was Ursula Weatherford. There are three family heads of that name listed in the 1790 census of N.C., Charles Weatherford <8>, Thomas and William Weatherford of Hillsborough District of Caswell County. The last bordered on the Cabarrus Co., region.

“ Dr. Talley owns a very interesting bullet mold which was hidden in a crevice of the Burleson cabin when it was abandoned during the Indian forays. The mold was found on David’s return to Tenn. Between 1805 and 1808. On May 1, 1805 David Burlison of Montgomery Co., N.C. sold 150 acres of land in that county to Barry Baxley for \$250 (unfortunately for all concerned the early records of that N.C. county were destroyed when the courthouse burned down in the 19<sup>th</sup> century). The first known Burleson land entry in Rutherford Co., Tenn. Was recorded in 1808 when Moses Burleson, David’s son, bought from Best Ward 127 acres for \$254.00. David himself is first recorded as buying land

there four years later, 1812, when he bought 100 acres for \$400.00 from Mourning Hobson. “

“ Only John above, son of David Burleson, and a Joseph, perhaps a son of this John, are listed with their families in the 1820 census of Rutherford Co., Tenn. It is likely that David and his wife were then sojourning with relatives in another state, perhaps with daughters Sarah Rowland and Mary Brooks in Concord, Cabarrus Co., N.C. or with son Moses in Jefferson Co., N.C. <AL> His son William was then recorded with his family in Lawrence Co., Tenn. which borders on the Ala. Line. Other sons were probably with their families in Marion Co., Ala. at the time of the 1820 census. <Blount Co., AL.>

“ As to the marriages of David's known children, although eleven of them married, we know only the names o the respective husbands and wives:

“ That David Burleson was a man of prominence and respected in his community is born out by the dozen of papers and notes bearing his signature or mark, or relating to him, now in possession of Lawyer Talley, who is also fortunate enough to possess some ten or so letters written by David or his descendants between 1818 and 1855. They all bear witness to a strong sense of family relationship, paternal and filial love, and give the reader an insight into the deeply religious side of that Burleson family. Such moving introductions and closings as ‘Through the mercy I am spared to write you a few lines’ and ‘Your loving son and daughter until death’ are quite common in them.

“ In February 1828, David Burleson Sr., found it expedient to make his Will, which reads as follows (Will Book 8, pp. 499-500, Rutherford Co., Tenn.):

‘In the name of God amen. I David Burleson in the County of Rutherford and State of Tennessee Calling to mind that it is once appointed for all men to die, and being in my perfect mind and memory and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs according to my own desire, do make and ordain this my last will and testament disposing of my worldly goods in the manner following:

'I give to my beloved wife Ursula Burleson the following property to dispose of as she sees fit – 1 negro man by name of Samuel – One bay mare and colt – One sorrel horse – four cows – two beds and furniture.

'I give to my son John, Moses, David, William, Hill K. Burleson one dollar each. I also give to my daughters Sarah Rolling, Mary Brooks, Nelly Rolling, Margaret Pope, Ursula Self one dollar each. The balance of my estate whether named or not I give to my son Isaac Burleson to him and his heirs forever. In witness whereof I hereunder set my hand and seal this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of February 1829.

“ On the old Burleson home place near the site of the original log cabin stands a government marker placed by the Capt. Wm. Little Chapter of the D.A.R. bearing the following inscription:

'David Burleson, James Farris Battalion, Col. Wade's Reg., N.C.

Discharged Oct. 9, 1782: Died Aug. 13, 1832.'

“ May he be as well honored by his thousands of descendants living today principally in N.C., Tenn., Ala., Miss., and Texas!!!

“ I hereby certify and affirm that the foregoing four pages of records and data are authentic to the best of my knowledge and according to my on-the-spot research findings.
